Coach Healy returns for his seventh season at the helm of Saxon Baseball. A native of Greenlawn, New York, Coach Healy attended Bishop O'Connell High School in Arlington, VA where he was a catcher and designated hitter for the Knights. Coach Healy moved on to the College of William and Mary where he was a catcher with the Tribe from 2001-2004. The 2001 squad advanced to the Clemson Regional of the NCAA tournament after winning the Colonial Athletic Association Championship. While at the college, Coach Healy was a member of the Monroe Scholar Program.

Coach Healy has coached teams in the Potomac Generals program, McLean/Great Falls Babe Ruth, and most recently in the Chain Bridge Vikings program. These teams included the 2006, 2007, and 2014 McLean/Great Falls All Stars teams. They posted District championships in '06 and '07 with the 2007 and 2014 teams winning the Virginia State title. The 2007 squad advanced to finish 9th in the nation at the Babe Ruth World Series in Glen Allen, VA. Coach Healy has provided instruction to youth catchers throughout the region for many years including both baseball and fastpitch softball.

Kevin is regarded as one of the premier catching instructors in Northern Virginia.
